

Recycling Solid Waste Disposal Committee Minutes-November 7, 2017

Town of Brooklyn-Green County, WI-Recycling Committee

Committee Members Present: Kevin Santulis, Luke Richardson, Russ Cichy

The meeting of the Town of Brooklyn Recycling Committee was called to order at 6:30 PM at the Brooklyn Town Hall by Santulis. Santulis posted the agenda for public review on November 4.

- Minutes of the September 5 meeting were reviewed. Move was made by Richardson to approve, second by Cichy. Motion carried and minutes approved.
- Action Plan items discussed
 - Cichy announced the pro forma budget the committee forwarded to the Town Board in September was modified slightly by the Board and will be presented to electors.
 - Santulis announced his term on the Committee expires in 2018 but he is willing to serve another term.
 - Employee evaluations will be conducted in conjunction with the Committee's January meeting. Cichy and Santulis will invite employees to that meeting and ask them to come armed with ideas to improve the operation.
- Operations
 - Santulis announced we had ESI pick up 2 barrels of uncrushed oil filters on 10/31.
 - Santulis announced 102 tires were picked up by Liberty Recycling on 11/1. Room was made for storage of the chipper in the facility although as of 11/2 that had not yet been done. The Committee discussed the lag time for Liberty pickups was now a full month and since the tires and chipper cohabitate in the same space in the facility, we would plan on scheduling a delivery early March in order to free the chipper by April 1. Santulis will make this statement to the Board and say if the chipper is needed prior to April, the Recycling Center will require some notice to move tires.
 - Santulis stated the Town Board approved the Committee to repair the damage to the Town posting board at the Recycling Center.
 - Cichy reported on the status of metal recycling with Thor. Committee agreed this program is working well for the Town,
 - Santulis will be scheduling a pick up from Universal Recycling Technologies (URT) in the near future. We have not had such a pick up for a long time so we sought some direction from our representative from URT on how to package materials. This pickup will include sorted e-waste, light bulbs and the batteries sorted by the Mighty Mites. Santulis and Thor Mikkelson will be present for the pick up to assure it moves smoothly.
 - A new security camera was previously installed at the Recycling Center and since last meeting Cichy had a sign posted warning residence the area was under surveillance with language approved by the Town Board.
- Santulis will provide a report to the Town Board on Monday, November 11 at 8 PM.
- The next meeting is planned for Tuesday, January 2 at 6:30 PM.
- Cichy moved to adjourn, second by Richardson. Motion carried. Adjourned at 7:18 PM.
