Title: Establishing Split Shifts for Election Officials

Adopted: 6/8/2015

This ordinance supersedes ordinance #2013-0114 entitled "Establishing Split Shifts for Election Officials" with a change in numbering, format and wording but no change in substance.

The Town Board of the Town of Brooklyn, Green County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s.7.30(1), Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the selection of 2 [or more] sets of officials to work at different times on each election day.

There shall be 2 shifts for election workers on all election days. The clerk shall determine the hours of each shift.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s.60.80 Wis. stats.
