ADOPTING THE UPDATED GREEN COUNTY ALL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the Town of Brooklyn recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property; and

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save tax payer dollars; and

WHEREAS, an updated All Hazards Mitigation Plan is required by FEMA as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Brooklyn participated jointly in the planning process with Green County and the other local units of government within the County to prepare an updated All Hazards Mitigation Plan, which was made available for review via a Legal Notice and a copy of which will reside permanently in the Green County Emergency Management Office;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Brooklyn, hereby adopts the updated Green County All Hazards Mitigation Plan as an official plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Green County Emergency Management Department will submit, on behalf of the Town, the updated All Hazards Mitigation Plan to Wisconsin Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency officials for final review and approval. Minor changes made upon advice from Wisconsin Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency will not require re-adopting this resolution.
