
Title: Electrical Code

Adopted: November 11, 2019

- 1.1 AUTHORITY. These regulations are adopted under the authority granted by Wis. Stat. § 101.86(1)(a).
- 1.2 PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to promote the general health, safety and welfare of the public, and to maintain local uniformity with the administrative and technical requirements of the Wisconsin Electrical Code.
- 1.3 SCOPE. This ordinance applies to electrical wiring installations, excluding those set forth in § SPS 316.002(2) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code.
- 1.4 WISCONSIN ELECTRICAL CODE ADOPTED. The Wisconsin Electrical Code, Chapter SPS 316 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and all amendments thereto, is adopted and incorporated by reference and shall apply to all electrical wiring installations within the scope of this ordinance.
- 1.5 SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this ordinance and the Wisconsin Electrical Code it adopts shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town Board would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provision may be declared invalid. If any portion of this ordinance, including those adopted and included by reference, or the applicability thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons of circumstances shall not be affected thereby.
- 1.6 EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be effective December 1, 2019 and upon passage and publication as provided by law.

This ordinance was adopted by the Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Brooklyn at a regular meeting on the 11th day of November 2019, by a vote of 3 aye and 0 nay.
