RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN ADJUSTMENT TO THE MUNICIPAL LEVY LIMIT FOR INCREASED IN CHARGES ASSESSED BY THE BELLEVILLE, MONTROSE & EXETER FIRE AND EMS DISTRICT

Resolution #12-14-20B

WHEREAS, an adjustment to the municipal levy limit is allowed for increases in charges assessed by a joint fire department and a joint emergency medical services district organized under Wisconsin Statute 66.0602(3)(h) for each governing body served by the joint department, and

WHEREAS, the allowable adjustment is as follows:

The percentage increase in the total charges assessed by the joint fire department and/or the joint emergency medical services district for the current year relative to the total charges assessed by each department for the previous year must be less than or equal to the Consumer Price Index for urban customers, U.S. City average, as determined by the U.S. Department of Labor for the preceding 12 months ending on September 30 in the year of the levy, plus two percent.

WHEREAS, each governing body served by the joint department must adopt a resolution in favor of the increase in charges;

WHEREAS, the Town of Brooklyn is a governing body served by the Belleville, Montrose and Exeter Fire and EMS District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Board of the Town of Brooklyn, Green County, Wisconsin, approves an adjustment may be added to the tax levy limit for increases in charges assessed by the Belleville, Montrose and Exeter Fire and EMS District, as determined above for the 2020 tax levy and all future tax levies until determined otherwise.


