## **CALLING ALL RESIDENTS: ABOUT THE REVALUATION**

In fall 2023, our Assessor's Office will complete a full revaluation. This is a town-wide review of all property assessments. Value adjustments are necessary to guarantee that all property is assessed properly to ensure that taxes are distributed equitably.

### E-WASTE -FREE-August 12, 15, 19, 22 Brooklyn Recycling Center

#### E-waste includes:

- Computers (desktops, laptops, tablets)
- Monitors
- Computer peripherals (keyboards, mouse, external hard drives, etc.)
- Printers (including those that scan, fax &/ or copy)
- E-readers
- Televisions and other video display devices
- DVD players and VCRs
- Cell phones

All other days, there is a nominal fee for e-waste disposal.

### OPEN YOUR DRIVEWAY

When an emergency occurs, Fire &/or EMS needs to get to your home. Please be sure all private driveways in the Town are navigable by Fire, EMS and other emergency vehicles.

The driveway clearances must be a minimum of 14' tall and the clear width shall be a minimum of 6' to each side of the driveway surface for a total of 26' wide clearance, this is particularly an issue with trees and brush infringing on these required clearances.

Need a minimum of a 25' turnaround area at the end of the driveway and on longer driveways, keep the turnout areas required every 300' graveled and clear for emergency vehicle passing lanes.
